Since being selected as your Ministerial Search Committee on February 14, 2013, here's what we've been doing.

Activity & Time Spent	Total
Retreat 40 hours (less 7 hours spent sleeping)	1980 minutes
42 meetings x 90 minutes (average duration)	+ 3780 minutes
5760 x 7 MSC members= 40,320 minutes (672 hours)	5,760 minutes
Cottage meetings = 9 x 60 minutes (average)	+ 540 minutes
22 interviews x 45 minute (average)	+ 990 minutes
Total	7,290 minutes
Reading UUA resource documents, correspondence, creating survey tools, developing interview questions, developing the BRUU Congregational Record & the BRUU packet, reading Ministerial Records & reviewing packets, et cetera.	+ 600 – 1200+ minutes
10 – 20+ hours per person per week (depending on the tasks at hand) x 52 weeks = 520 – 1040 hours X 7 MSC members = 3640 -7280 hours	
Total	7,890 – 8490 minutes
