Unitarian Universalists agree to uphold the following principles to the best of their ability:

1 st Principle:	Recognize the inherent worth and dignity of every
	person.

- <u>2nd Principle:</u> Observe justice, equity and compassion in human relations.
- <u>3rd Principle:</u> Accept one another and encourage spiritual growth in our congregations.
- 4th Principle: Pursue a free and responsible search for truth and meaning.
- 5th Principle: Respect the right of conscience and the use of the democratic process within our congregations and in society at large.
- 6th Principle: Build a world community of peace, liberty, justice for all.

 7th Principle: Respect the interdependent web of all existence of which we are a part.

As a result, many feel an unresolved discomfort with their spiritual beliefs and would like to move to a sense of affirmation and integrated spiritual wholeness. 
The Disappearance of the Universe -- a New discussion group -- Songoing




